



The Carriage House on the grounds of the

Heritage Village and Farm Museum, Troy, PA was constructed in the 1880's for the Troy Fair which will be celebrating its 150th anniversary in 2026. Constructed to be the Merchants Building, it is one of two remaining original Troy Fair buildings.

In 2005 the building was considered for demolition but was donated to the Museum. Efforts proceeded to raise the necessary funds to move the building. Just imagine magnitude of that task. Once moved it received a new roof. was painted and repainted in 2015

The historic building itself is an exhibit and filled with the area's largest collection of horse drawn buggies, sleighs, wagons and farm equipment.

The building's 88 windows need replaced, estimated cost of \$13,200 (\$150 per window)and would need to be custom made. The windows are an important feature as they provide the needed natural light.
