Pennsylvania Heritage Festival / Maker's Market Information

- Vendors are responsible for collecting appropriate
 State Sales Tax on sales made during the Festival.
- Insurance and appropriate state -regulated license for vendor, booth and product are vendor's sole responsibility. A Certificate of Liability Insurance for the event is requested.
- Liability Insurance available through actinsurance.com
- Handcrafted vendors will be in the Heritage Village.
 Direct Sales and non-profit organizations in the upper meadow, Flea Market vendors will be located in front of the museum building.
- Organizers have the right to withdraw any item deemed inappropriate. If the item is not removed, the vendor will be asked to leave and not invited to participate again.
- Craftspeople are encouraged to demonstrate the skills
 of their crafts at their booth during the show to help
 authenticate the spirit of the show. The more you
 demonstrate the more attraction you bring to your
 craft.
- Vendors are responsible for tents, tables, chairs and trash removal.
- No electric or water available at vendor sites.
- Security will be provided from 8:00 PM Friday to 8:00 AM Saturday and 6:00 PM Saturday to 8:00AM Sunday; however the Festival cannot be responsible for any losses or damages before or during the event.
- Children are to be under adult supervision at all times.
- There is no rain date. The Festival operates 10:00AM to 5:00 PM on Saturday and 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM on Sunday.
- Vendors must remain open during the full time frames of the festival (10-5 Sat. 10-4 Sun.)
- A deposited check is a commitment to the Festival.
 Refunds minus a \$10 processing fee will be given until Aug 25, 2023.
 No refunds will be made after Aug 25, 2023.

- Festival organizers will direct vendors to their locations between 1:00 and 6:00 PM Friday,
 September 16 and 7:00 AM - 9:00 AM Saturday,
 September 17, 2022.
- Break down and removal of booths may begin after the Festival Gates close at 4:00 pm on Sunday. Any vendor breaking down and leaving early or pulling out after one day will not be invited to return. Clean-up and departure must be completed by 7:00 pm Sunday night.
- No open containers of alcoholic beverages.
 Participating Wineries sales only.
- Placement is assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Vendors' booths must not interfere with adjacent booths.
- Camping is available via Alparon Park at 570-529-1984
